For Boys (VI to XII)

Same as above with sky blue divided knee length skirt.

For Boys (Nursery to VIII)

Same as summer uniform with following additions: Navy blue tie with light blue stripe. Navy blue V-necked cardigan with light blue stripes around neck and hands. Full sleeve shirts.

For Boys (IX to XII)

Navy blue tie with light blue stripe. Navy blue blazer with logo. Light Blue Trousers.

For Girls (Nursery to VIII)

Same as summer uniform with following additions: Navy blue tie with light blue stripe. Navy blue V-necked Cardigan with light blue stripes around neck and hands, full sleeve blouse.

For Girls (IX to XII)

Navy blue tie with light blue stripe, Navy blue blazer with logo. Light blue skirt.

P.T. Uniform

For Boys and Girls both (III-XI)

Half sleeve T-Shirt of individual House colours (Red, Blue, Orange, Green) with School Monogram, three light blue strips in collar and sleeves having individual House name at the back, Navy Blue track pant with three stripes, White socks and White P.T. shoes.
