




The Vision

From The Principal's Desk







Affiliation

The School is recognized by the School Education Department, Government of West Bengal and is affiliated to the Council for The Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), New Delhi, (ICSE & ISC).

Curriculum

The School follows the syllabi prescribed by the CISCE and integrates this Syllabus into a Curriculum which is dynamic in content and application. The Curriculum is child centric as far as practicable, within the framework of a general syllabus prescribed for a particular class.

Remedial Classes

There is a special provision for Remedial Classes for weak students round the year and for all students prior to terminal examinations of the School. Special classes are arranged for students weak in a particular subject, in lieu of some curricular activities during the time allocated for this.

I.T. Education

Information Technology has turned the world into a Global Village now, and today's children need to get its full benefits as well as understanding.

Faculty

Whatever we have been able to achieve is due to the unwavering dedication of our staff members. The dedicated staff has striven to create an atmosphere of 'Share and Care' and is engaged in the process of self-development.



The school provides audio-visual learning through graded courseware for classes playhouse to the highest class.

It also provides the entire computer education for the school keeping in view the astronomical pace of development in communication and other field of human activities.

National Benchmarking

With a view to comparing the standard of internal evaluation process with respect to national standards, the school arranges National Assessment for its students, These tests provide an opportunity to evaluate child's ability and performance at an examination, on a national level. The process of assessment provides a scope for getting the child's ability tested among her / his own peer group on a national scale.



Continuous Learning

It is believed that a teacher must continue to learn in order to remain a teacher. All teachers and administrators at the Aryans go through a continuous process of amelioration through various seminars, workshops, symposia, demonstration lessons, quest lectures, etc.

Teachers have also been attending workshops on English Language Teaching (ELT), mathematics, physics, biology, preprimary methodology and so on, every year on a regular basis.

















Co-curricular Activities

The Co-curricular Activities typically include inter-house quiz, talent search, singing, School choir, debating, story-writing, handwriting, poetry-writing, elocution, dancing, art & craft, salad-dressing, ikebana among many others.

Through Class Assembly children of each class get a chance to display their talent through a skit, dance, singing, recitation etc., based on a theme relevant to their lives.

Extra-curricular Activities

Among the extra–curricular activities, we have regular games like Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Table Tennis, Carom, Chess, Scrabble, and also Karate, Mediation, Yoga, Dramatics etc.

Social Activities

In tune with the curricular requirement of the Council for the ISCE, New Delhi, the School has provision for Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW) in the curriculum.

Competition & Cooperation

The School is divided in four 'Houses' for better management of activities and also to instill a sense of healthy competition and the spirit of cooperation among the students. Every house is in the care of a House Parent who has a group of House Teachers as assistants. Each house also has a House Captain and House Prefects from amongst students, which brings out and refines the leadership qualities among them from a very receptive age.


Encouraging Talent

The School encourages students to participate in The Telegraph in Schools (TTIS) & Newspaper in Education (NIE) movements. Subscription to these helps to groom the child, inculcating leadership and literary qualities, along with fostering other academic and curricular traits that the child already possesses. It organizes fest-cum-carnival for over 200 Schools of West Bengal for discovering their talents in various co and extra-curricular activities.

The Mother Building

The Main Building houses a large indoor assembly area, the school library, audio visual room, a computer laboratory with state of the art computers with broadband internet facility, a well-equipped infirmary, and 20 classrooms. It also hosts the staff room and the Vice-principal's office. A central PA system enables communication throughout the building.

The New Building

The new building houses 40 classrooms, staff rooms, offices, a very large library, a large modern computer laboratory, lift and a ramp up to the top floor for physically challenged persons.

Administrative Block

The Administrative Block houses the offices of the Secretary, Principal, Waiting Lounge and a Conference Room.



Student Facilities

Each classroom is spacious, airy and well lit with a class library. Ergonomically designed furniture, suited to the relevant age group, make learning stress free.







The Canteen

The School has a large hygienically-maintained canteen for students and staff, where freshly prepared, sealed and packed food is served under the supervision of a Canteen-in-charge. Fizzy drinks, chewing gum, deep fried chips and other fast food are not supplied to children from the school canteen.

The Math Lab


A new inclusion to generate interest in Mathematics and to bring back the joy of learning Mathematics is the Math Lab from NIITn guru. It will help the students to overcome Math phobia and to comprehend the subject.

The Library

The school library which was formally inaugurated on the Independence Day, 2006 has grown in its volume over the years and needed to be shifted to the new building in a bigger area. It is now a state of the art centre of excellence.

The Laboratories

The building PRAYOG which hosts three laboratories for Chemistry, Physics and also Biology cum seminar hall, was inaugurated on 15th August, 2006 by Hon'ble Justice Shyamal Kumar Sen. The special feature of the chemistry laboratory is its gas chamber which is authorized by the competent authority for its safety parameters.





Health Services

In addition to this, the School has provision for regular health check up for students on campus and free eye check up for each student by Vasan Eye Care, under the care of a team of doctors.

Counselling Services

Psychological counseling for students and parents, where required, academic counseling for parents on various education related issues and career counseling for senior students are some other 'services' provided.


