



STATE OF THE ART

The school building is fully equipped, air-conditioned classrooms and filled with much natural light, is supported by international standard teaching aids including Smart Class technology.

SPACIOUS

Ours is the first state-of-the-art academy of the SSRVM Trust, spread over 1.5 acres, in the heart of Kolkata.

LIBRARY AND LABS

Our well-stocked Library, hi-tech science and infotech labs - are all designed to arouse a student's curiosity and desire to find answers to life's mysteries.

ROOM FOR MULTI ACTIVITY

Play areas comprise a basement hall, an indoor mini-gym, a multi-purpose hall for group performances, an open, paved courtyard for yoga and dance, senior art, pottery and design room, senior dance and music room besides a basketball court, badminton courts, table tennistables and an open playground.

INFIRMARY

The school also houses two infirmaries with trained Nurses, to provide timely care.

ELEVATORS

Large, regularly-maintained elevators to carry as many as 20 children at a time to their respective floors. Special care has been taken for the requirements of physically-challenged students.

BUS FACILITY

All the buses are clean, air conditioned, well maintained and handled by an efficient transport team. A Smart Bus tracking system has been installed in all the buses in order to monitor the movement. The GPS tracker empowers parents to know their child's location with the help of an app. There are two helpers (one male and one female) along with the driver in all the buses to look after the safety of the children.

SAFE

The campus is safe, clean, and hygienic with landscaped gardens. The school has its own reverse-osmosis water purifiers to ensure the supply of safe drinking water.



DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY LAB

At the design technology lab of Sri Sri Academy, young minds unleash their creativity in designing and assembling something new, and getting to know the working behind them. These young creators of tomorrow clad in aprons with saws, hammers and chisels in their hands, work on wood to give shape to their creativity and thoughts to create products out of wood that make a difference in the way we live.

ATAL TINKERING LAB

Atal Tinkering Laboratories (ATLs) has been assigned to Sri Sri Academy by Niti Aayog with an objective to foster curiosity, creativity and imagination in young minds; and inculcate skills such as design mindset, computational thinking, adaptive learning, physical computing etc.

MATH LAB

A Mathematics laboratory is a place where students experience Math through informal exploration. Sri Sri Academy has a Math Lab for students of Classes II to VI where they explore the world of Mathematics by solving puzzles, doing hands-on activities using lab equipment. These create interest among students and help understand mathematical concepts visually.



SMART CLASS TECHNOLOGY

With the aim of nurturing the inherent potential and talent of each child to create global tech citizens of tomorrow, every class till Senior School and laboratories at SSA have been equipped with world's first fully integrated one-switch Digital Interactive Teaching system (DTS) and CTS (Classroom Transformation System) by Educomp Solutions Ltd.

The CTS broadens the choice of teaching tools available with the teacher beyond invaluable rich 3D Animations to bring abstract concepts to life and it also includes interactive technology oriented tools like ready to use MCQs, Virtual Laboratory of Simulations, Work Sheets, Mindmaps, Teaching Ideas, Real Life Applications, Topic Synopsis, Weblinks, and Diagram Maker.

It not only improves the academic performance of students but also assists the teachers to meet day to day teaching challenges.



THE CURRICULUM

PRE-PRIMARY (LOWER NURSERY-CLASS I)

- A child friendly world where each child experiences the joy of learning
- Has a thematic and activity-based curricula
- The environment is specially designed and equipped with Montessori materials and latest educational toys so that the child naturally develops numerical, linguistic, creative, physical and artistic skills



- Study of Sanskrit, a basis of most Indian languages and a language of our ancient scriptures deepens the appreciation of our rich cultural heritage
- Physical Education, specialized games such as Basket ball, Karate, Yoga and Meditation, as part of the curriculum to emphasize the importance of a healthy mind in a healthy body for holistic development of qualities and attitude essential for a well-rounded personality
- In Class VIII, the academic programme is designed to develop the theoretical knowledge and practical skill of every child. The subjects offered at this level are English, Bengali, Hindi, Sanskrit, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, History, Geography and Computer Science

PRIMARY (CLASS II - V)

- A hands-on approach complementing theoretical exercise helps to develop a spirit of enquiry based on the sound pedagogical belief of 'Learning by Doing'
- Language and numeracy skills are developed through specific subjects such as English, Vernacular, Mathematics, General Science and Environmental Studies
- Equal stress is laid on academic as well as extra curricular activities such as Music, Drama, Physical Education, Yoga, Karate, Art and Craft and Technology.
- Children spend 'Quality Circle Time' with their class teacher in which various issues like discipline, honesty, environment, cleanliness etc are discussed in an openforum

MIDDLE SCHOOL (CLASS VI - VIII)

- Studying of three branches of Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) along with Humanities subjects (History and Geography) kindles the spirit of enquiry and exploring the scientific phenomenon in everyday life through multifarious activities/ experiments in well-equipped Math/Science Laboratories
- Focus on strengthening the language, numerical.
 Scientific and IT skills to lay the foundation of development of interest in relevant course of study in higher classes







SECONDARY (CLASS IX - X)

- In Class IX and X, the children have the option of choosing either Science or Commerce according to their aptitude
- Core: English, Second Language (any one Hindi, Bengali), History, Geography, Mathematics, compulsory for Science and Commerce Stream has an option between Mathematics and EVS.
- The subjects for the Science Stream would be Physics, Chemistry, Biology
- The optional subjects for Science Stream would be Computer Applications, Home Science and PE
- The optional subjects for the Commerce Stream would be Economic Application, Computer Applications, Home Science and PE





SENIOR SECONDARY (CLASS XI - XII)

- The High school degree conferred by the Indian School Certificate Examination is recognized both nationally and internationally.
- Courses offered are Science, Commerce and Humanities. (*Refer to choice of subjects in page no: 17)
- English is compulsory.

Objectives of the course:

- To enhance the appreciation of English through aural, oral and written assessments
- To help students acquire in-depth knowledge in their choice of subjects through application oriented / project based / research oriented learning
- To develop quantitative and logical aptitude in relevant subjects
- To consolidate learning through field / educational trips in relevant subjects

Science Stream

To enable students to develop an understanding of the concepts and fundamental laws of Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

Commerce Stream

To develop an understanding of important Economic concepts and to study the important aspects of Accountancy and Commerce.

Humanities Stream

To sensitize students towards local and global social, political and geographical scenarios encourage them to develop their own views.

ALL ROUND HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT





In order to nurture children to grow into happy, well-read, and responsible citizens, every aspect of our work at SSA is planned to make learning both enjoyable and stress-free. The children's section is truly engaging and vibrant. The classes are equipped with a host of innovative learning tools and kits from international names in the field; these are bound to arouse a child's curiosity and capture his/her imagination and interest. There is also a library filled with resources and an exciting new gym for little learners, to help them explore as they grow. The many games and tools are provided to sharpen their sensory skills while the happy and carefree atmosphere, right down to the colourful furniture, makes SSA a delightful haven for children.

Here they can be themselves and grow up to be confident, responsible leaders of the next generation.

CARE AND COUNSELLING

To ensure that children are completely safe at SSA, the school has made arrangements for medical support. Our modern Infirmary is appropriately equipped and supervised by experienced medical professionals.

We also have trained in-house counsellors and special educators to offer personalized attention and care to children who might find it difficult to cope or open up in class and share their concerns and difficulties.

Career Counselling / Guidance: SSA has in-house trained Career Counsellors. Psychometric Tests are held each year for Classes VIII and XI for students to make the appropriate selection of subjects and stream according to their interests, aptitude and personality.





TRAINED TEACHERS

Teachers at SSA are specially trained in value education. They are child-friendly and trained to teach with compassion, qualities essential in an education system where basic human values are encouraged.

At SSA we believe that each child is endowed with these values. It requires a trained teacher, working in tandem with the parents, to better develop the child's values of "compassion, co-operation, friendliness, smiles, laughter, lightness, wanting to help, a sense of belonging and caring for each other" as our Founder has stated.

Our teachers recognize the need for the complete

development of their students. They understand that mind and body are so indissolubly linked that what is put in the body reflects on the mind, and what happens in the mind impacts the body.

Teacher-student bonding forms an integral part of our school culture. The students are encouraged to freely articulate their doubts and questions.

We believe that children feel strongly connected to teachers who nurture and care for them. This creates a safe and friendly learning environment and encourages spontaneity and intellectual curiosity in the students.








STUDENT EVALUATION

The academic year at SSA will have two Terms, based on which two assessment reports will be given to each student. The evaluation will be an on-going process with an emphasis on assessing what the child has understood in class. Weekly assessments will be taken to develop regular study habits and prepare students for senior school.




Evaluation in the Primary segment will be based on grades (not marks) which indicate a range of proficiency in certain skills and concepts selected for assessment. This prevents stress in the early years and keeps a child from unnecessary competition and parental pressure to perform which might otherwise rob him/her of the joys of learning.



Term exams will be gradually introduced to prepare students for senior school. The portion to be assessed will be enhanced in each class in a planned and scientific manner. Each Term's Evaluation will comprise of continuous Class Assessments and Block Test at the end of the Term. Year's assessment will be based on the performance in the First and SecondTerm in both Scholastic and Co-scholastic areas. Merit Cards/Credits for Achievement/Progress in Scholastic and Co-scholastic areas, are given to appreciate and motivate students to maintain their consistent performance.

Curriculum and evaluation is as per the guidelines laid down by the Council in Humanities, Commerce and Science streams. There will be three block tests in each of the three terms.










PARENT SUPPORT





To address and better facilitate this role, SSA holds special, two-hour "KNOW YOUR CHILD" and "KNOW YOUR TEENS" workshops for the parents.

These programmes help the parents to understand their child's behaviour in the correct perspective and mould their response accordingly to help the child grow into a confident human being.










Application & Admission Process for 2026-27 session



¹Documents to be attached with online application form:

- (i) Soft copy of passport size photograph of the child and both parents individually (each file size should be below 50KB).
- (ii) Copy of Birth Certificate of the child issued by Municipal Corporation / Panchayat.
- (iii) Copy of Latest report card received from the school currently studying in.
- (iv) Copy of the Acknowledgment of the Income Tax Return / Form 16 / Salary slip of any one of the parents.
- (v) Proof of the educational qualification (as mentioned in the online application):Copies of Certificate/Mark sheet of both parents.

Documents to be submitted before the session starts:

- (i) Final Report Card from the last school attended. (Optional for Nursery)
- (ii) Original Transfer Certificate from the last school attended (Optional for Nursery)
- (iii) Doctor's Report, if the child has/had any major illness

²For admission to **Pre-Nursery**, **Lower Nursery**, **Upper Nursery and Kindergarten**, there will be **no written test**. The readiness of the child, for the level applied for, is observed. Both parents should be present for parent interaction.

For all other levels written test will be conducted on **English**, **Mathematics**, **Vernacular and Science** (Science is applicable only for Classes VIII, IX & XI-Science).

Withdrawal & Refund Rules:

In case of withdrawal, Fees are not refundable, no matter if the student has attended classes or not from the beginning of the session. **Fees once paid, is not refundable, only Security Deposit will be refunded**, after all dues to the school are cleared.

Please Note:

Intimation of interaction schedule for all Nursery classes, Kindergarten and Class I will be uploaded on the school website and sent through email on and from 1st July 2025. Interaction/admission test for all other classes will be on 13th September / 8th November, 2025.

Criterion for Admission to Class XI:

- Science: An aggregate of 75% with at least 75% marks in Mathematics and Science.
- **Commerce**: An aggregate of 70% with at least 75% marks in Mathematics.
- **Humanities:** An aggregate of 70%


[Students opting for Mathematics have to secure at least 80% in the aptitude test, to be conducted by school] Candidates, found ready, may get provisional admission, subject to clearing the Class X Board Examination. A minimum of 85% attendance of the working days during each year of the two-year course at school is the basic requirement.

Conditions of Eligibility for Admission to Class XI:

- In accordance with the ISC requirements, all students admitted to class XI have to select subjects which they wish to study at the + 2 level (classes XI & XII).
- In addition to English (Compulsory) five subjects have to be chosen, except in Science stream, where only four elective subjects have to be chosen.
- Students will be given provisional admission to Class XI which will be considered for confirmation after the declaration of Board Results.
- Depending on the Class X Board Results and performance in school assessment till June 30, the school reserves the right to ask for a change in Subject/Stream. Students, who have opted out of science at the Class X board, will not be permitted to take up Science Stream at the ISC level / Class XI.
